Dear Spring Creek- Matanzas Families,

The purpose of this communication is to update you regarding the consolidation of Spring Creek and Matanzas onto the Matanzas campus for the 2021-2022 school year. There are many decisions that factor into developing a TK-6 school, and the staff and administration at both sites are excited to embark on this journey!

The school consolidation also presents an opportunity for the Spring Creek Matanzas parents and students to help guide our process for combining our sites, while maintaining the excellent programs we already have at Spring Creek and Matanzas. The visioning process for consolidation of the schools will begin with Spring Creek Matanzas staff this Spring, with ample opportunities for parent, student, and community input throughout the 2020-2021 school year, beginning in Fall 2020.

Transition FAQs

Which school site will house the TK-6 program?

All TK-3 students will remain at Spring Creek for the 2020-2021 school year. All 4-6 students will remain at Matanzas for the 2020-2021 school year. Starting in the 2021-2022 school year, TK-6 will consolidate onto the Matanzas campus.

What will happen to the Spring Creek campus in 2021-2022?

Starting in 2021-2022, the Spring Creek campus will become Rincon Valley Charter School, RVUSD's charter 7-8 middle school.

Will the current Spring Creek 3rd graders move to Matanzas for the 2020-2021 school year?

Yes! We will be welcoming our new 4th graders to Matanzas in August!

Will the learning outcomes change because we will be on a consolidated campus?

Although learning outcomes will not change, the opportunity for more targeted learning in specific areas will be possible due to the expansion of resources by combining the two campuses. Examples include more intervention offerings, more flexibility with resource support in classes, more opportunities for buddy classes, and a stronger emphasis on diversity and inclusion will be possible at the consolidated campus.

What will happen with the staff from both sites?

By merging both campuses in 2021-22, we will retain as many staffing positions as possible and reduce overhead in other areas. Consistency in teachers and programs will be a top priority during this consolidation.

Will Extended Care be provided at the Matanzas campus?

Yes, Extended Care will be provided at Matanzas starting in the 2020-2021 school year. Spring Creek will also have Extended Care for the 2020-2021 school year. Extended Care will then continue at Matanzas for the 2021-2022 school year.

We understand that there are many more questions that will arise during this process, and we are always available to help you navigate these changes. As the planning and visioning begin in earnest in the Fall of 2020, we look forward to hearing from you at parent input evenings and in surveys, and look forward to creating the new TK-6 campus together!
