CRISIS HEALTH PROTOCOL

- Nurses will continually work with school staff to monitor for any symptoms (fever over 99 and cough will immediately result in parent contact for pick-up/Care Connect clinic visit; staff sent home)
- Any employee who has traveled out of the country, to include their child, must self-monitor at home for a minimum of 7 days and be symptom free before returning to work.
- Any employee who has traveled, or who resides with someone who has traveled, from a high-risk area (currently China, Iran, Italy, S. Korea) must self-monitor at home for minimum of 14 days and be symptom free before returning to work. Employees may return after the 14-day period with a clear physician Fit for Duty form completed.
- Any Current student who has traveled outside of the U.S. will be required to delay returning to school for a minimum of 7 days from the date reentering the U.S. and be symptom free. Students will be marked present and participate in their education through the Digital and Alternative Location School Day Plan. Parents are to notify the school in the event of travel.
- Students who have returned from a high-risk area will be required to delay returning to school for a minimum of 14 days from the date re-entering the U.S. and be cleared by a physician. Students will be marked present and participate in their education through the Digital and Alternative Location School Day Plan.
- Current students who are living with or have been in direct contact with someone who has traveled from a high-risk area will be required to delay returning to school for a minimum of 14 days from the date re-entering the U.S. and be symptom free. Students will be marked present and participate in their education through the Digital and Alternative Location School Day Plan.
- New students enrolling in the district and who have come from outside the U.S. will be required to delay starting school for a minimum of 10 days. Students will have access to CareConnect for a confidential medical evaluation. Clearance from a medical professional will be required.
- New students enrolling in the district who have come from a high-risk area will be required to delay school attendance for 21 days. At the end of the 21-day period, the student may elect to use CareConnect for a confidential medical evaluation. Clearance from a medical professional will be required prior to attendance at school.
- In the event of a school closure, all students will be provided access to the Digital and Alternative Learning School Day Plan. Materials will be provided for pickup at the scheduled bus stops and available digitally.
- Any employee, student, family, or enrolling student who has traveled outside of the U.S. should contact the school via telephone for guidance on the implementation of the CCSD protocol.
