Facility: Underwood School is located at 123 Summit St., Underwood, ND. In 2013, we completed work on a new 6-lane rubberized track located to the southwest of the school. Two rubberized runways with sand pits on each end supply our long and triple jumps. The shot put is located on the south end of the football field, inside the track. The high jump is on the north end of the field also inside the track. The javelin and discus are thrown just to the north of the track on two separate fields.

Meet Dates and Times:

Start times for all meets are as follows: Field: 3:00 Running 3:30

Junior High Meets – April 7, 16 – One division

Varsity Open Meets – April 23, May 7

Cost: All meets are \$10 per athlete per team up to a maximum of \$150 per school. Make checks payable to **Underwood Public School**.

Relays: You may run more than one relay team per school. Only one relay team may place.

Rosters: Please email Brandt Dick (brandt.dick@underwoodschool.org) before attending any of our meets to let us know you will be attending. All our meets will require teams to register your entries on www.athletic.net. Deadline for registration is one day prior to a meet, Noon.

Awards: Medals for top three individual places. Ribbons for 4th through 8th place and relays. Junior high will be receiving ribbons for 1st through 8th place.

Relay Markers: NO TAPE allowed on any of the rubber surface. Chalk will be available for relays and will be available for runways and high jump pad.

Stickers: We do not plan on requiring stickers as all our events should be pre-seeded.

Spikes: No spikes longer than 1/4 inch (pyramid or cone only) will be allowed. ABSOLUTELY NO PIN SPIKES.

Bathrooms: There will be porta-potties available near the track.

Concessions: Served by the Underwood Comet Club.

Meet Workers: We will do our best to provide at least one adult worker at each event and all timers. We may need coaches to help until everyone arrives.

Team Camps: No tents or throwing implements are allowed on the football field. All teams are expected to clean up their areas before leaving the facility.

Admission: JH Meets: Adults \$3 Students & Seniors \$2 / Varsity: Adults \$5 Students & Seniors \$3

Please do not drag hurdles on the track surface. Hurdles must be lifted, carried and placed.

Jewelry: The wearing of jewelry will not be allowed in the high jump event.
