



Frequently Asked Questions

What time does school start?

NEW School Hours:

- Students may not be dropped off before 7:30am
- School starts at 7:50am (tardy bell)
- PK Students dismiss at 1:55
- K-3 Students dismiss at 2:55 (Early Release Friday is at 1:55)

Who is my child's teacher?

- Classroom assignments will be sent via email to families at 7am on Friday, August 12th. They are sent to the email address listed in PowerSchool.
- East Elementary Campus will be open for Meet the Teacher on Friday, August 12th from 9:00-11:00.
- No schedule changes will be made at that time; however, if there is a concern please reach out to our counselors.
- If you don't receive an email on the 12th from your child's teacher: check your spam folder, ensure you have completed your child's enrollment, or check to make sure you entered your email address correctly

Transportation:

Your child should know how they are to go home each day before arriving at school. ***If there is a transportation change, please call the office before 2:15 PM with the alternative method of going home. Students are prohibited from riding on buses other than their regular assigned bus.*** If you have questions regarding bus transportation, please contact the transportation department at 918-366-2247.

Pre-K – Third grade:

Car rider number is available at Meet the Teacher in the gym. The number must be displayed on the passenger sun visor or hanging from the rearview mirror. Drop off and pick up will be as follows:

- Pre-K, K and 1st will be dropped off and picked up at the west entrance of the elementary building. Parents are requested to stay in their cars and allow the students to be loaded into the car.

- 2nd and 3rd grades will be dropped off and picked up at the east entrance of the elementary building. Parents are requested to stay in their cars and allow the students to be loaded into the car. If the student has a younger sibling, students may go load and unload in the west entrance with the PK-1st grade sibling, so that the parents only have one stop.

All students must be picked up and dropped off in the appropriate locations. Students may not be dropped off in the bus loop, surrounding neighborhoods, or in the parking lots.

Can I walk my child to class?

- Week 1: Parents can escort their child to class if they arrive prior to the tardy bell (7:50). You will need your car rider tag to avoid having to check in at the office with your ID.
- Beginning Aug 22nd, we would like to encourage students to walk to class independently. We will have faculty stationed throughout the hallway to help direct students as they learn their way. Any parent will need to use the safe school ID system in the front office to gain a visitor's badge.
- Please remember that the goal is for our students to transition to school successfully! We welcome ALL parents into the building but need to get busy learning so please be mindful of the bell schedule. We appreciate your support in developing student independence with the morning routine.
