We appreciate the effort of our custodial staff to deep clean our building each evening and everyone who disinfects regularly touched surfaces throughout the day. We appreciate our teachers encouraging students to properly wash their hands, cough into their elbows, and dispose of tissues. We also appreciate parents who are making sure children get plenty of rest and those who have kept children home when they are sick. We are grateful to our nurse and local health department who continue to share information regarding COVID-19 and measures we can take to prevent its spread.

As I continue to closely monitor the spread of COVID-19 in our nation and state, it is becoming increasingly obvious closing school for an extended period of time may be necessary. While I have no immediate plans to close school, I strongly recommend families plan for this contingency. I understand families will have many questions in the days ahead and we will do our best to answer each one and share information as it becomes available. In the interim, our district will continue to deeply clean our buses and campus while working with students to practice good hygiene throughout the school day.

As our Governor just shared in his address this evening, there are only two confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Missouri, both of which were travel related. At this juncture, there have been no documented instances of community infection or person-to-person transfer in our state. Our district is committed to continually monitoring developments relative to COVID-19 made available to us by the Camden County Health Department and the CDC. I would like to assure you we take the health and wellness of your children and your entire family very serious and we are doing everything we can to ensure everyone's safety. We will continue to stay abreast of developments and will continue to share information with you. At this juncture, we feel strongly our campus is a safe place for teaching and learning.


