Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are excited to once again offer Connected Learning Days. A Connected Learning Day will allow students to work remotely from home in the event school is cancelled. Traditionally, we have added days to the end of the school year to make up for lost days. These missed days mean that educational momentum is lost. If school is cancelled, District 52 may use Connected Learning Days. It is important to note that we may forgo Connected Learning Days and the missed days would be made up using the scheduled make-up day(s) at the end of the school year. Information regarding whether a school cancellation will be a Connected Learning Day or a traditional make-up day will be communicated via phone and email.

Important Information for Potential Connected Learning Days:

- Connected learning provides a continuation of current classroom instruction at home on the day of a cancelled school day. All teachers will be available from 9:00 A.M. - 2:30 P.M. so students/parents can contact the teachers with Connected Learning Days questions, if needed.
- Teachers will express expectations in class prior to a potential Connected Learning Day. See the list below indicating where assignments for each teacher will be located. Paper copies of some assignments may also accompany your student.
- Students will be considered present if class assignments are completed. Students will be considered absent if the assignments are not turned in by the expected time.

Washington Middle School and District 52 hopes these Connected Learning Days will help our students use skills the one-to-one computer initiative offers. Lessons will be prepared by each teacher that are a continuation of the material currently being discussed in each classroom. Please refer to the checklist on page two to ensure your student is getting the most out of his/her Connected Learning Days.

- ☐ I will talk to my teachers about completing any work not done on the Connected Learning Day.
- ☐ I will let my parents know about the feedback I received for the work that was completed.
