Dear Families and Guardians,

All Alden-Hebron Schools Closed - Starting Monday, March 16

District 19 will close schools to help contain and mitigate the continued spreading of the coronavirus (COVID-19). We currently have no known cases of COVID-19 in District 19.

Starting Monday, March 16, 2020, and continuing through March 27, 2020, (and evaluating day by day/week by week there after), District 19 will close all schools. Teachers will provide instruction through e-Learning curriculum for PreK-12 students.

Spring Break

Spring Break is from March 23 through March 27. No e-Learning days will occur during the break.

As the current health situation continues to evolve, our principals and our teachers have been working to develop general plans for student learning in the case of a school cancellation. We are prepared to utilize e-learning days in District 19.

I had previously said that we would start e-learning after spring break, but our D19 Team has decided to begin e-learning days Monday March 16th. We anticipate some kinks this first week, so we thank you in advance for your flexibility and support.

- Students will be expected to complete assigned activities **daily** for full attendance credit.
