Dear Families,

Simpson County Schools has been approved to offer Non Traditional Instructional Days (NTI) from March 16th through April 3rd. This means that Simpson County students can access instructional materials while they are home in situations that prevent students from being in school. The NTI days will limit the interruption of learning that occurs due to school closings. Students can access their work via paper copies or digitally.

For this to be a successful endeavor, we need your help!

- For each missed NTI day, parents will need to access the following website.
 - Go to www.simpson.kyschools.us- and select Menu at the top- then click on NTI Instruction under Student Links or you can access the following direct link: bit.ly/fsnti20.
- You will select what grade your child is in and you will see five days of assignments for Reading, Math, Science, Social Studies, and special area activity. The menu page that appears will need to be signed by a parent and returned to your child's teacher. Work completion will be monitored by both the teacher, school, and district.
- You will find two options for your student to complete. Option 1 will be a paper assignment to complete. Packets will be available at each school to be picked up. Option 2 will be an online platform for students to access and work online. If you need a chromebook to complete the online work, a parent or guardian must come to Franklin Simpson High School from 8:00-10:00 during NTI period to check a computer out. Once students return to school, they will have 7 days to complete the work and return the computer.
- Simpson County will be providing lunch and breakfast for the following day from Franklin Simpson High School and Simpson Elementary from 11:00-1:00. This service will be provided as a drive through option. A student(s) must be in the car in order for a meal to be provided. In addition, bus drivers will be running their regular routes with meals to be provided to students. If transportation is an issue, please call 270-586-8877.
