Good evening,

Thank you for your patience and partnership as we work through these very challenging and uncertain times. Our public health situation is changing from moment-to-moment. This is a very complex and dynamic situation.

I wanted to provide another update before the weekend regarding COVID-19 and where we stand as a district. As of right now there is no imminent plan to close school and we are expecting that students will be in class on Monday. However, if there is a development over the weekend including regional or state agencies determining closing is appropriate, we will let you know as soon as we do. We have no guidance or directive indicating that we will be required to close schools at this point.

Today, during our regularly scheduled Superintendent's Conference day, our staff worked to put together educational plans that can be shared with students to continue their learning at home if that need should arise. This was a proactive decision so that we are not waiting until we need to do something.

We will hold on to these plans until there comes a time that we need to use them. We know that uncertainty creates a great deal of anxiety. We are working to balance the needs of our families and community with public safety. IF we were to close for an extended period of time, our primary focus will be mobilizing to ensure food stability for our families most in need.

The advice continues to be, keep careful care over those who have pre-existing health conditions that require more sensitivity to COVID-19 and continue proper health hygiene and social distancing. We are all in this together - we will work through the uncertainty, the fear and worry for those we love. We will continue to update you as more information becomes available.
