This is your own story, not copied from any of the versions we have already read. Make sure it is an original story created by your own imagination. It must have a beginning, middle, and end. Build into the story and make it creative. Here is a guideline on how much you should have done during the two week absence.

March 16th-20th: Write a sketch on scrap paper as to what the setting of your story is, the characters you want included, and the resolution you want in the story. By the end of this week, you should have the beginning (introduction of characters and setting) of the story finished and be working on the middle (events that take place/plot) of the story.

March 23rd-27th: Finish the plot of your story and also the resolution or ending of the story. There is usually a conflict in every story. This is the part where the conflict is resolved.
