Dear Parents/Guardians:

In case the Gallatin County Schools are forced to shut down to stem the tide of the Corona Virus, I have prepared packets of work for the students to complete at home. This will be vital to keep the students on track and get them ready for 2nd grade. **Please complete 1-2 pages a day from each packet. The grammar packet only needs 1 side completed every day. If we come back to school before the packets are finished please send the whole packet back to class.** I will be testing the students on this material when they come back.

Packets: Math: 2 pages each day

Phonics: 2 pages each day

Grammar: 1 side of a page each day

Reading/Spelling: 2 pages each day (these are not torn from a book)

Practice (students know it as O Book): complete pgs. 199-210 the first week and pgs. 211-222 the second week

Week 1: The spelling and high frequency words are on the back of the schedule in your child's folders, along with the stories they should be reading.

Week 2: Spelling words: cart, barn, arm, art, yarn, harm, happy, key, four, none

High Frequency words: four, large, none, only, put, round

Stories: A Barn Full of Hats – pg. 120

A Lost Button from Frog and Toad – pg. 140

If we are out longer, the school **may** provide more packets to be picked up.
