E-Learning Program for Pandemic Preparedness

IL School Code: 105 ILCS 5/10-20.56, E-Learning days

1. Ensure and verify at least 5 clock hours of instruction or school work, as required under Section 10-19.05, for each student participating in an E-Learning day.

Students will be given up to 5 hours worth of assignments from multiple subject areas per day. All assignments are due two weeks after we return to school.

Administrators, teachers, specialty area staff and support staff will be available via email from 8:00 to 11:00 and 11:45 to 1:45.

K-4 Grade Level Teams and Grade 5-8 Teachers have created a matrix of assignments for students to complete for up to 5 hours.

Grade 5 -8 teachers will communicate school assignments through Google Classroom by 8 a.m.. Alternate assignments will be provided for students who do not have internet access.

The grade level matrices and related documents will be posted on the website under "E-Learning", by grade level, for parents and students to view by phone/device as necessary.

A copy of a grade level matrix will be sent home with students the day before a school closing, if possible. A phone blast will be sent explaining to parents where grade level work will be posted on the website and if they are unable to access this by internet, they may visit their child's school for a copy of assignments by grade level in a box in front of the school.

Students will be given 4 assignments per day. Students who complete 3 or more assignments within the matrix will be marked with a full day's attendance. Students who complete 2 assignments will be considered "half day of attendance" and students who complete no assignments will be considered absent.

2. Ensure access from home or other appropriate remote facility for all students participating, including computers, the Internet, and other forms of electronic communication that must be utilized in the proposed program.

Parents/Students will be given all login information per online programs: Google Classroom, Pearson Realize, Dreambox, IXL, Mystery Science, STEMscopes, TCI, Newsela etc...

9. Ensure that all teachers and staff who may be involved in the provisions of E-Learning have access to any and all hardware and software that may be required for the program.

Every teacher and specialist is provided with a laptop with access to Google Suite for Education and educational apps. ELA, Math Science, and Social Studies curriculum is available digitally.

10. Ensure an opportunity for any collective bargaining negotiations with representatives of the school district's employees that would be legally required, including all classifications of school district employees who are represented by collective bargaining agreements and who would be affected in the event of an E-Learning day.

The District 48 E-Learning Program was developed in collaboration with SCEA union leadership.

11. Review and revise the program implemented to address difficulties confronted.

The District 48 E-Learning Program will be reviewed annually by the administration and the District-Wide Technology Committee.

12. Ensure that the protocol regarding general expectations and responsibilities of the program is communicated to teachers, staff, and students prior to utilizing an E-Learning day.

Families and students will be notified via Email Blast, Automated Phone Message, Salt Creek School District 48 websites, and Social Media (Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter).
