Hello Bulldog Families,

The following statement is from a press release from State Superintendent of Schools Dr. Carmen Ayala, regarding the mandatory closure of all Illinois schools: "**This mandatory closure takes effect Tuesday, March 17. Currently, we anticipate the closure to last through March 30.**"

At this time, this means the Mahomet-Seymour Schools will resume school on March 31, 2020.

INFORMATION ABOUT EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

In light of today's announcement from Governor Pritzker closing all schools through March 30, 2020 **all extra-curricular practices** have been added to the list of already suspended or cancelled competitions, and community gatherings. This suspension of practices is effective immediately for all Mahomet – Seymour Schools and will continue through Monday, March 31, 2020.

With respect to the continuation of activities, any decisions made related to the rescheduling of any athletic contests or the resumption of practices would not likely be able to be made until after Monday March 31, 2020.

Listed below is an important reminder from the IHSA as it relates to non-school participation and the resumption of Spring Sports and Activities:

During the suspension of the spring season, athletes should not practice or compete with their non-school (club/travel) teams or they will be ineligible for the high school team if and when the suspension is lifted.
