Food service locations

At District 88, the well-being of students is our No. 1 priority. We are committed to making sure students continue to receive food service while they're not in the buildings.

District 88 is partnering with Addison School District 4, School District 45, Salt Creek School District 48 and places throughout the District 88 community to provide meals. See details below.

Who is eligible to receive meals?

Any community member up to the age of 18.

What meals will be served?

Breakfast and lunch will be available.

When will meals be served?

Breakfast and lunch will be available from 10 a.m. to noon from March 17 to 27 (Monday through Friday).

Will there be a cost?

No. This service is being provided free of charge to all residents up to the age of 18.

How can meals be picked up?

District 88 transportation providers will deliver food to the locations listed below for students and other community members up to the age of 18. Look for the school bus in the parking lot at each location.

We also are working with students who receive door-to-door transportation to coordinate meals.
