As we continue to get more information and guidance from the State of Wisconsin Governor's Office, Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction, Wisconsin Department of Health Services, and Buffalo County Health Department, the School District of Mondovi has made the decision to close school at the conclusion of the school day Tuesday, March 17 through the end of Sunday, April 5 with the hopes of returning on Monday, April 6.

During this time, along with following the latest recommendations regarding COVID-19 (Coronavirus), students will still have opportunities to tend to their schooling. Elementary School students should have received a packet of activities while Middle/High School students will be monitoring their academics through their assigned chromebooks. All students and/or parents will have the opportunity to email their teachers for any support that is needed - staff will be on standby to support their students however they can.

The School District of Mondovi also plans to continue providing breakfast and lunch food service for our students, starting with lunch on Monday, March 23. District students outside of a two-mile radius may have meals delivered while those within the two-mile radius may pick up.

As many of you know, this situation continues to be VERY fluid. The School District of Mondovi will be diligent in our monitoring. Any new updates will continue to be added to the School District of Mondovi website, under the "COVID-19" tab.

To conclude, the District would just like to share how proud we are of all our students and staff. They are handling this difficult situation with confidence and compassion. We are prepared for this event thanks to a lot of hard work by both our students and staff. Communication will be essential during this extended closure.
