Subject: Enrichment packets and student meals

As a district we are striving to support our students and families through this unprecedented time. Over the last two days we have come up with a plan to address some educational challenges as well as meal concerns. We will be offering free meals to all children who are 18 years of age and under starting on Thursday March 19th. These meals may be picked up in the high school circle drive between 11:30 AM and 1:00 PM every week day that we are closed due to Covid 19. You will not need to leave your vehicle as a member of the school district will bring the meals to your vehicle as you come through the circle drive.

We have also developed enrichment packets for our students. These packets will be available both online as well as hard copies for all students. The online packets will be accessed through google classroom. Anyone who does not have the internet or would prefer a hard copy packet may pick up a packet in the high school circle drive on Friday March 20th from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM. These packets are for enrichment purposes to help guide our students and parents through some educational opportunities. Please make sure you read the letters posted by our building principals to help guide you and your student through this information. All packets regardless of grade level will be picked up at the high school circle drive. Principals and secretaries will be posted in the high school building on Friday March 20th from 11 AM to 1 PM to pass out enrichment packets. If you prefer to access these packets online please follow the directions posted in each principal's letter. Enrichment work that is completed may be turned in via google classroom or by hand at a later date. If you are using the hard copy packets please make sure you keep completed work together in a folder to return to school at a later date. Please keep in mind that the work being sent home is for enrichment purposes. This work will not be counted against their grade in any way. Middle school students and high school students will be able to receive some extra credit towards their current grade in a class by completing the enrichment packets.
