Dear Parents and Students,

As Mr. Lasater has already stated, the health, safety, and well-being of our students and community is of the utmost importance to Lockwood school district. It is also very important to us that we continue to provide educational experiences for your students during these trying times. LHS students will be able to access enrichment work for all of the content areas we offer through google classroom or by hardcopy. **If a hardcopy is required it can be picked up Friday, March 20, from 11am-1pm.** In order to incentivize students to complete this enrichment work we are offering extra credit equivalent to five percent (5%) of the total points available in the class. Content areas must be completed in full by April 6. If the closure were to extend past April 6, more enrichment work could be provided.

Google Classroom

If a student is enrolled in a class that uses google classroom, enrichment work will be posted there. Enrichment work for classes that don't already have google classrooms can be found on a shared classroom called Lockwood High School. The code to join that class is: 47syepy. Enrichment activities for vocational agriculture, physical education, foreign language, computer applications, keyboarding, art, and music can be found there.

Packets/Band Instruments

Hardcopies of enrichment packets can be picked up at the front door of the high school on Friday, March 20, from 11am-1pm. Band instruments can be picked up at the same place and time.

Dual Credit
