Earlier this evening you received a notice announcing the launch of the KDHSA Distance Learning and Continuity of Care program. Your teachers, administrators, counselors and staff have been working non-stop over the past 3 days to prepare for the changes that are to come, and we hope you engage in some of the fun, and sometimes embarrassing, videos and activities we have for you.

Families, we are all too aware of how different everything feels right now. Freshmen have had their first year of high school cut short, and seniors have been stripped of some of the exciting activities that come at the end of the school year. If the adults in your world are still working, then you may be watching younger siblings or caring for neighbors. There is no road map, no guideline to tell us how to handle this.
