WHEREAS, the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic is impacting our nation;

WHEREAS, as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, school is closed for an indefinite period of time, and

WHEREAS, an additional consequence of the COVID-19 pandemic is the uncertainty of being able to hold public meetings for an undetermined amount of time, and

WHEREAS, this school closure could create a financial burden for some of our staff during this period of school closure and create a risk to the school of losing its investment in such staff and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Superintendent is authorized, empowered, and directed to take any and all actions necessary and desirable and that is permitted by law to ensure the safety and well-being of Adams Central Community School students, employees, and school community for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year without further action by the school board. This resolution expires at the end of the current school year or upon a majority vote of the members of the Board of School Trustees, whichever shall first occurs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board that as long as Adams Central Community Schools remain closed as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic for the 2019-2020 School Year, all staff will be paid for their regular hours on non-instructional or e-learning days, as permitted by law and applicable rules and regulations. All staff will be considered on call and may be required to work during their normal working hours as directed by their supervisor.
