## **Professional Development/Updates:**

- -RSU #34 K-12 Special Education Staff Meeting for November will focus on the development of Behavior Intervention Plans. Leigh Broughan from UCP of Maine will be joining us to assist us in this work. Leigh Broughan is a BCBA who provides consultation and training in this area. This work will provide staff with skills to address the needs of students presenting with behavioral challenges as a result of trauma and other factors.
- -Maine Department of Education (MDOE) is in the process of revising the Maine Special Education Regulations, Chapter 101. The MDOE has held a public hearing for comments and written comments are due by December 3, 2018. Areas of great interest across the state are changes to Child Development Services and programming for State Agency Clients and State Wards.
- -Southern Penobscot Regional Program Update: The Building Resiliency with School-Age Children had 140 attendees from the area. The feedback to date has been very positive.
