We would like to provide you with an update after the events of the weekend in regards to COVID-19 and how it relates to our students, staff, families and community patrons.

1. Governor Asa Hutchinson has directed all Arkansas public schools to remain closed until Monday, April 17. Searcy School District is following his directive and will continue to monitor the situation and follow any additional directive from his office. All school athletics and other activities are cancelled during this time period. All staff and student school travel is suspended until further notice.
2. All students and teachers will participate in AMI Days 1-5 during the week of Monday, March 16-Friday, March 20. Spring Break will follow during the week of March 23-27.
