- All Charlton County Schools remain closed until March 31, 2020. Should the closures extend beyond this date all parents will be notified.
- All practices, activities and rehearsals have been canceled until further notice.

Should the closure extend, the school system will seek to provide all our students, especially those without internet and technology access, printed and digital resources that can be used for academic remediation and enhancement.
- The Charlton County School District will begin a Grab 'N Go Lunch and Snack Program Monday, March 23, 2020. Individuals 18 years of age and younger may pick-up a lunch at two curbside locations, Charlton County High School and St. George Elementary School, between the hours of 11:00 AM – 11:30 AM. Per USDA requirements, the child must be present. Families are reminded to please use Center for Disease Control guidelines as it relates to stopping the spread of COVID-19 when picking up the meals. The school system is exploring other methods to use in the distribution of meals.
