Meal Pickup: For our families whose children walk to school, we have established the following two locations where you can receive a grab 'n go prepared lunch meal (for the current day) as well as a breakfast meal (for the following day).

- Sultan Middle School 301 High Ave, Sultan, WA 98294

Meals are available to all persons age 0-18 years, free of charge. Please look for signage at the buildings to direct you to the offering location. People are encouraged to obtain the meals and not congregate at these locations as it is contrary to the goal of maintaining, "Social Distancing" protocol.

Time of this offering will be 10:00am to noon, Monday – Friday. PLEASE NOTE – these locations will be closed (and services not provided) during the week of Spring Break – 04/06/20 thru 04/10/20.

Meal Delivery: Our staff has been making calls today directly to our families that have children who ride the bus. This is to help us determine how many families would like to have meals provided to their students. Existing bus routes are being adjusted so that we can utilize school buses to deliver both meals and educational material to your student's regular bus stop on a daily basis (Mon - Fri). The timing of these stops is still being finalized but our goal is to have all stops/deliveries completed no later than 12:30pm each day.

As the current Covid-19 situation is still very fluid, the above protocol is subject to modification pending new developments. We will provide updated guidance/direction to you ASAP should things change. We will also be looking at options to possibly increase access to these services in response to feedback received from our district families.

It is our endeavor to make this process as quick and easy as possible for all Sultan School District students to continue receiving the meals that they would typically enjoy during normal school operations. Thank you in advance for your patience and understanding during this challenging time.

Las comidas están disponibles para todas las personas de 0 a 18 años, gratis. Busque señalización en los edificios para dirigirlo a la ubicación donde se entregarán las comidas. Se motiva a las personas a obtener las comidas y no congregarse en estos lugares, ya que es contrario al objetivo de mantener el

protocolo de "distanciamiento social". El horario de esta oferta será de 10:00 a.m. a mediodía, de lunes a viernes.
