

Dear Parents and Guardians,

If you are watching the news you can see how fast things continue to change and therefore we must continue to push forward being prepared for what potentially could be next.

We will be opening the buildings on Monday for students/parents to come in and grab their personal belongings, Chromebooks, and instruments.

We will be open from 1:00 p.m to 8 p.m on Monday, March 23rd, and Tuesday, March 24th from 1:00 p.m to 6 p.m..

At the 7-12 building, students will need to enter through the main doors (office) and then will exit through the doors near the auditorium.

We will only allow five students in the building at a time and we will have designated spots for the students to wait outside or they can wait in their vehicle. We will follow the guidelines of keeping the students apart.

1st and 2nd grade students/parents will enter the building on the west side. In addition, K, 3rd-6th on the east side. We will have staff there to help locate what is needed. We will allow five in at a time on the west side and five at a time on the east.

We will be sending home Chromebooks (2nd-12th) for those who need them. Student devices are assigned and documented to know which device was given to each student. You will be allowed to keep your device until we ask for them back. All devices have filtering on them.
