### SHELTER-IN-PLACE LETTER

Dear Lansing School District 158 Community,

On March 20, 2020, Governor J.B. Pritzker announced a shelter-in-place for all Illinois residents from Saturday, March 21 through Tuesday, April 7 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. All District 158 schools will continue to remain closed through this date. Additionally, all non-essential personnel will now be working fully from home. **Grab-and-go breakfast and lunch meals will continue to be offered Monday-through-Friday, 9:00 AM-11:00 AM from the Coolidge Elementary School Kitchen and home learning activities may still be picked up from the kitchen during these times.** However, our school offices will no longer be open in the morning. Administrators and other staff will be available to answer questions via email but please be patient during the shelter-in-place if you attempt to contact us through phone or mail. Week 2's home learning activities have been uploaded to the "Documents" folder on our district website and you may access these at any time using the link below:

Previous week's home learning activities will continue to remain accessible to you, as well, and educational staff listed may be contacted with questions. Finally, I am happy to announce that the seven member school districts of the Thornton Fractional Educational Consortium (TFEC) have joined together to ensure that all of our students remain fed during the school closure. Starting Monday, March 23, any of our children age 18 and younger may pickup grab-and-go meals from all nine of the school sites listed on the attached joint statement. It is our hope that this flexibility will help support all of our families during this crisis. District 158 is continuously monitoring the COVID-19 status and will provide updates as they become available. Please observe the Governor's shelter-in-place order and continue to prioritize the health, wellbeing, and safety of your families and loved ones.

### CARTA DE ORDEN DE REFUGIO

Estimada Comunidad del Distrito Escolar 158 de Lansing,

El 20 de marzo de 2020, el gobernador J.B. Pritzker anunció una orden de refugio para todos los residentes de Illinois que permanezcan en su hogar desde el sábado 21 de marzo hasta el martes 7 de abril debido a la pandemia COVID-19. Todas las escuelas del Distrito 158 continuarán cerradas hasta esta fecha. Además, todo el personal no esencial ahora trabajará completamente desde casa. **El desayuno para llevar y las comidas para el almuerzo continuarán ofreciéndose de lunes a viernes, de 9:00 AM-11:00 AM de la cocina de la escuela Coolidge y las actividades de aprendizaje para el hogar todavía pueden ser recogidas de la cocina durante estos horarios.** Sin embargo, nuestras oficinas escolares ya no estarán abiertas por las mañanas. Los administradores y otro personal estarán disponibles para responder a preguntas por correo electrónico, pero por favor sea paciente durante la orden de permanecer en hogar si intenta ponerse en contacto con nosotros por teléfono o correo. A partir del lunes 23 de marzo, cualquiera de nuestros niños de 18 años o menos pueden recoger comidas para llevar de los nueve sitios escolares que aparecen en la declaración adjunta. Esperamos que esta flexibilidad ayude a apoyar a todas nuestras familias durante esta crisis. El Distrito 158 está monitoreando continuamente el estado del COVID-19 y dará actualizaciones a medida que estén disponibles. Por favor, observe la orden de refugio del Gobernador y permanezca en hogar y continúe priorizando la salud, el bienestar y la seguridad de sus familias y seres queridos.
