Dear Parents,

If your child has medication at school, please call the office to discuss picking up your child's medication as soon as possible.

Be proactive in staying healthy by:

- Washing your hands with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds or using hand sanitizer that has at least 60% alcohol.
- Cover your mouth and nose when sneezing or coughing.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth. Avoid others who may be sick.
- Stay home from work if you are sick. If your children are sick, keep them home from school or daycare. Symptoms of COVID-19 include: Fever, cough, and shortness of breath.
