As many of you are aware, the Governor issued a directive that ensures all Essential Persons have access to childcare so that they can remain on the job to protect and care for Vermonters. This directive requires schools to develop childcare plans that best fit these unique and unprecedented circumstances during the COVID-19 crisis.

In partnership with our local childcare facilities and the St. Albans City Recreation Dept., Maple Run Unified School District is currently working on a plan of how we can provide childcare to **enrolled students from Pre-K to Grade 8 of Essential Persons** during regular school hours.
