At present time, BCHS will be closed **Saturday, March 14th to Sunday, April 5th.**

Dates

- **No entrance** is allowed to any part of the campus by anyone from **March 15th-April 5th.**
- Prom has been rescheduled from Saturday, March 28th to **Saturday, May 16th.**
- The last day of school has not been changed and is **Friday, May 22nd.**
- Graduation is still scheduled for **Friday, May 22nd at 6pm** in the BCHS Gym.
- As of now, **Spring Break will be substituted with these weeks off,** and all faculty, staff and students should plan to attend school during that week (April 6-10).
