- I am monitoring our current class sizes and projected enrollment for next fall. We held our preschool child find (screening) on March 24th and our kindergarten pre-enrollment that same week.
 - We currently have 27 students pre-enrolled for Kindergarten, 16 three year olds and 20 four year olds pre-enrolled for preschool. We have submitted our preschool at-risk grant.
