Currently, we are in the process of state testing. Thank you to all of the teachers for preparing our students to do their best. Also, thank you to Mrs. Basart for keeping the technology running strong. A deserving appreciation to the SHS staff for preparing breakfast/snacks for the students on testing days. It was amazing seeing the kids congregate in the lounge to eat, visit, and breathe before the tests began. We also held a Pep Rally to kick off the Spring testing with positive messages from staff.

FastBridge Assessments have been wrapped up with a few possible makeup tests to be completed. The students have worked hard to show improvement as the ELA and Math tests become more challenging as the year progresses. These tests help drive instruction and have shown we have come a long way in nine month's time but also demonstrate that we still have room for improvement.
