- Anyone found violating the rules will be banned from using the wifi service.

3. Violating Copyrights – Copying, downloading, or sharing any type of copyrighted materials (including music or films) without the owner's permission. Winona Montgomery Consolidated School District assumes no responsibility for copyright violations by students.
4. Copying Software - Copying or downloading software without the express authorization of the principal or assistant principal. Unauthorized copying of software is illegal and may subject the copier to substantial civil and criminal penalties.
