The best news I have for today is that there is little news. My daily conference with our Commissioner of Education and department leaders yielded no surprises. Locally, we do know of a confirmed case of COVID-19 in Doniphan County. On a more positive note, our food service and other staff served meals to approximately 350 children today.

Teachers are continuing to develop lessons and engagement activities. They are communicating and many are already engaging our students. Our state department and Service agencies have been helpful in providing ample resources for professional learning. As you can imagine, this new culture of school will require a lot of new learning for our educators.

Hiawatha High School students and families received student belongings yesterday. It was orderly and successful. It was managed and monitored to ensure student safety. Hiawatha Elementary and Hiawatha Middle School will begin the same process tomorrow. Those schools have contacted families with details. In addition to personal belongings, schools are sending home learning materials and electronic devices such as laptops and iPads. A majority of instruction will be done electronically. Those who do not have internet access will be provided packets of printed materials.
