AMES students and parents will checkout devices and pick up students personal belongings on Wednesday, April 1<sup>st</sup> from 9-11:00 A.M. Please come to the front door by the office.

\*\*AMES teachers and students will begin academic work on Thursday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>.

\*\*Teachers will be using Dojo to communicate with parents. If you are not on Dojo, please email your son or daughter's teacher so that you can be added.

\*\*If your student is on an IEP, the ANW Special Education Teacher will continue to be in contact with you and provide services as directed by ANW.

\*\*Research and evidence has shown that a reasonable expectation for kids to engage in online learning every day is between two to three hours. That expectation of time is lower for elementary aged kids. We tried to create activities and lessons that fall within this range.

**Preschool:** Mrs. Walker will be using Lexia for her classes. Students will be given login information.

**Kindergarten through 4<sup>th</sup> grade:** These students will be using Lexia Reading and Symphony Math. Both are Web-Based applications that have been loaded into the device that your student will have checked-out to them.

\*\*Individual teachers will also be sending home packets with students for enrichment activities.

Teachers will be available from 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. Monday through Friday for support and or questions. I know many have already been in contact with you.
