



Internet Access Options for C-I Families / Students during COVID-19

Due to the COVID-19 virus pandemic, the demand for internet access has increased as more people are practicing social distancing by staying at home, telecommuting and engaging in distance learning.

In an effort to help our families and students gain access to internet services, we have put together a list of a few local providers that are offering free internet services to students and their families.

Reminder, internet access is not required for students to partake in distance learning. Printed materials will be dropped off for families that continue to not have internet available.

CTC

- FREE public Wifi hotspots have been set up at the CRES and High School buildings.
 - Other nearby CTC hotspots include Block North Brew Pub in Aitkin and Mission Town Hall.
- There will be no need to leave your vehicle or enter any nearby buildings in order to access the WiFi. Simply park in the area and search for a network named "CTC WiFi". It will be free to use and will allow anyone to access high-speed, reliable internet from a safe location.
