First is some general information on our Continuous Learning Plan (CLP). Below that you'll find the CLPs for all three buildings that has been broken up into 4 different areas. Thank you all for your grace and patience.

### **District Calendar:**

USD 224 will continue to follow the BOE approved calendar for the 2019-2020 school year. This means that there will be no 'office hours' or assignments released on Friday, April 10, or Monday, April 13, 2020. Additionally, the last week that learning opportunities will be presented will be the week of May 11-15. This will allow students to return assignments early the week of May 18. The last week for learning opportunities to go out for seniors will be the week of May 4-8.

### **Communication Plans:**

We will use many communication outlets during this time. Email, Facebook, Twitter, School Live Feed/Notifications, and the SeeSaw app will be used. If you have technology or learning issues please email or call the teacher directly and allow them some time to work with you to resolve the issue. Teacher emails are included in the document.

## Preschool, Kindergarten, First Grade, Second Grade, and Third Grade

The Pre-K- 3rd will be using Seesaw as a platform for students and parents to access lessons and information. The lessons can be accessed on the app anytime that works best for your family. There are no specific times each day that you have to be on Seesaw. As a reminder, please do not stress about the lessons. We are starting slowly to get you and your student familiar with the app. Each student will have a 12 digit code and a QR code. Either will get them into the app. Attached is an image with step by step instructions. Your child's teacher will be in contact with you to receive the 12 digit code. A paper copy with both versions of the code will be available with your student's school items.

Our teachers will mainly focus on math and ELA (English Language Arts) during this last 9 weeks of learning. Other subjects may be taught within those two areas. Specials such as PE and Music will be communicated through the app. We will release a lesson each day using the following schedule:

1. Go to <https://app.seesaw.me> on a computer in Chrome or Firefox browser. Or install the Seesaw Class App on an iOS and Android device.



2. Choose "I'm a Student".



3. Scan this code using Seesaw's built-in QR code scanner. Or type in these letters to access your Seesaw account: **SKKU** [redacted]

## **4<sup>th</sup> Grade and 5<sup>th</sup> Grade**

Here are step by step instructions to help you and your student(s) be successful in completing paperless homework/activities.

*Step 1:* Log onto: [www.classroom.google.com](http://www.classroom.google.com) or download the Google Classroom Application on your smart device. The student will then log on using their email and password.

*Step 2:* We created a new class for the students to use for this situation; they will NOT go onto their old one. They can do 1 of 2 things. They need to go to the small plus sign in the upper right-hand corner and you will join a class. The codes are listed below for their grade level.

*Step 3:* Assignments will be uploaded on the “steam page” with the date in which students should complete the activity. We will release math and science on Mondays, Reading and Writing on Wednesday’s and Friday we will be doing a fun STEM Friday challenge and PE Activity as well as a google hangout for any questions before assignments are due! There is one on there currently that is labeled “1st Assignment.”

*Step 4:* Students should complete the activity and click submit at the bottom if it calls for that. In the case of the first assignment, the student will add a class comment.

*Step 5:* Once Students have submitted their assignment, they should return to Google Classroom and click Mark as Done. (This will ensure the teacher is notified once they’ve completed their assignment.)

## **6<sup>th</sup> Grade, 7<sup>th</sup> Grade, and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade**

The 6-8 will be using Google Classroom as a platform for students and parents to access lessons and information. An email to join the classroom has been sent out. The codes are also listed here:

In the Continuous Learning Classroom, students will receive daily messages on the stream for what subject(s) they will be working on that day. They can then go to that teacher's classroom to read and complete the assignment. Students will have a week to complete an assignment from the day it is assigned. Here is the weekly schedule for assignments:

Below you'll find the information for CCHS Students. With our 1-1 Chromebook initiative you are very familiar with the Google Classroom format so this should go smoothly, overall. We'll have some issues, but through grace and patience we can work through them.

Teachers have been divided up into two different release days. The learning opportunities will be released in Google Classroom on these days. This is to try and not overwhelm anyone no matter where we are at in the plan. Also, each teacher has an 'Open Hangout Hours' portion of their week where you can just hop on and ask anything. Additionally, each teacher is available through email and will be sharing a phone number to reach them at during the day with their individual classes.

It is highly important that students check their email a couple of times a day as information changes and more guidance is given.
