

STUDENT AUTOMOBILE USE REGULATIONS

In accordance with the policy of the Valliant Board of Education, the following rules and regulations shall govern student parking at the public schools:

1. Students who drive vehicles to school park at their own risk and must understand that the school will not be held responsible for damage to a vehicle. Although the parking areas are monitored, students are encouraged to keep vehicles locked.
2. Students who wish to park a motor vehicle in any school parking area must register the vehicle with the school and must possess an appropriate and valid Oklahoma operator's permit or license.
3. Once parked, student vehicles may not be driven until school is dismissed for the day, with the exception as outlined in Valliant Board of Education policy FFFD.
4. Students may not sit in, or upon, or congregate around vehicles at any time during school.
5. Vehicles shall not be driven on any grass area, around the junior high school, or upon or into any area not designated as a driveway or parking area.
6. Students may not drive motor vehicles to lunch during the lunch period.
7. Tags, bumper stickers, signs, or flags that suggest profanity, advertise tobacco or drugs, or are inflammatory or degrade another person because of race, gender, creed, or culture are prohibited.
8. All state laws, city laws, ordinances, and school rules and regulations shall be strictly enforced.
9. Any student in violation of any of these rules shall have their driving privileges on school premises suspended for the remaining term of the school year.
10. Stereos should be used in a manner that does not disturb school operations or neighbors. Failure to observe this regulation will be cause enough to have the student barred from driving to school.
