

**VEHICLE USE AND PARKING
STUDENTS**

The Valliant Board of Education will permit student use and parking of motor vehicles on the high school campus only. Students driving a motor vehicle to the high school campus may park the vehicle only in the parking lot designated for student parking. Students will not park vehicles in the parking lot(s) designated for staff and visitors. The vehicle will not be used during the school day. In the event of an emergency, permission may be granted for a student's use of a vehicle.

Students driving a motor vehicle to the high school campus may park the vehicle in the parking lot designated for student parking. Students will not park vehicles in driveways, on private property, or in the parking lot located in front of the school. The vehicle will not be used during the school day unless the student is enrolled in baseball, softball or golf and has written permission from the legal parent or guardian that the student may drive or ride in a personally-owned vehicle, and then only during the sport season, to the student's respective field. Students acquiring permission to drive or ride to their playing field must exit the student parking lot onto Section Line Road and proceed directly along that route, with no detours, to their playing field. Students cannot use their vehicles to return to school, run errands, or other uses during school hours. In the event of an emergency, permission may be granted for a student's use of a vehicle.

Students are permitted to park on school premises as a matter of privilege, not a right. The school retains authority to conduct routine patrols of student parking lots and inspections of student automobiles when on school property. The interior of student vehicles may be inspected whenever a school authority has a reasonable suspicion that illegal or unauthorized materials may be contained inside. Such patrols and inspections may be conducted without notice, without consent, and without a search warrant.
