DRUGS, ALCOHOL AND CONTRABAND SEARCHES

The Valliant Board of Education believes that in order to respond to the drug and alcohol abuse problems in our schools and to maintain a reasonably safe school environment, the district may occasionally use trained dogs to search for drugs, alcohol, or contraband on school property.

Such searches will be arranged by the superintendent at his discretion and will target only school property including lockers and vehicle parking areas. Students and staff members will not be the subject of animal searches and will be searched in accordance with school policy FNF only if probable cause arises during a search of school property.

The superintendent is directed to prepare a regulation implementing and supporting this policy.
