
Student Chromebook Setup Guide


No network

Step 1:

To connect to the Internet, use a compatible Wi-Fi network.

- 1. At the bottom right, select the time to display the menu seen here --->
- 2. From the menu select the item No network to display a list of available Wi-Fi networks.
 - Note: If you see your Wi-Fi network name and a signal strength, your Chromebook is already connected to Wi-Fi.
- 3. Select your Wi-Fi network from the list and enter the Wi-Fi password.






- 5. After successfully connecting your Chromebook to your Wi-Fi network your Chromebook will continue to automatically connect to a known Wi-Fi network.
- 6. Allow the Chromebook to sit at the Google login screen for 2 minutes to load the most recent district profile.
- 7. Restart the Chromebook, continue to the next step.

Step 2:

Log into your school Google account.

- After connecting to the available Wi-Fi network enter your school Google account using your first.lastname format.
- District Google passwords for K-5 students are Blaine**** (* is student lunch code) 6-12 students use a common password for Google and Skyward.



3. After successfully logging into your Google account, check to make sure you have Wi-Fi signal

Open Chrome browser and click on the G-Suite application button to open the desired Google application
