Oceans of Possibilities

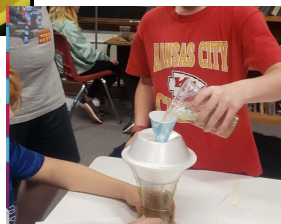
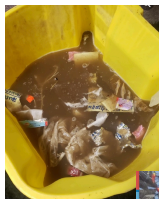

connections to concepts learned in the classroom.



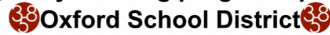
HirePaths
