September is Attendance Awareness Month

One of the district's school improvement goals is to reduce chronic absenteeism to 5%. If a student misses 10% or more of the school days in session, (either excused or unexcused) the student is considered chronically absent. Last year, the chronic absenteeism rate for the district was 13.8%, with the highest percentage of absenteeism in grades K-2 (averaging 28.7%).

Here are a few important facts about absenteeism from *Attendance Works:*

- 1. Absenteeism in the first month of school can predict poor attendance throughout the school year. Half the students who miss 2-4 days in September go on to miss nearly a month of school.
- 2. Absenteeism and its ill effects start early. One in 10 kindergarten and first grade students are chronically absent.
- 3. Poor attendance can influence whether children read proficiently by the end of third grade or be held back.
- 4. Research shows that missing 10 percent of the school, or about 18 days in most school districts, negatively affects a student's academic performance. That's just two days a month and that's known as chronic absence.
