How to Encourage Punctuality

Arriving late to school is another attendance issue that impacts school success Here are some tips for getting children to school on time:

- Establishing and keeping a schedule; children thrive on routine. Going to bed and waking up earlier- develop a set routine at night and in the morning
- Preparing for the morning the night before by laying out outfits, packing backpacks, and pre-packing lunches.
- If work schedules conflict, investigate other means of transportation, such as carpooling with other families; communicate with the school if additional resources are needed.

Professionals suggest tracking the average late, then add that amount of time to the schedule. For example: if you are consistently 15 to 30 minutes late in the morning, set your alarm 15 to 30 minutes earlier. Doing this creates a cushion of extra time for unexpected delays.
