This year it is also available for USD 358 students whose parents have a signed a consent form to receive the selected vaccines. The forms must be completed and returned by October 25th. The health department will also have COVID boosters available for those who chose. If you would like a vaccine, consent forms are in the main offices or the nurses office. Those wishing to have vaccinations will also need a copy of their insurance card and drivers license.
