Eligibility Reminders

Semester One Ends in Three Weeks

There are three weeks remaining in the 1st semester, which ends on Friday, December 16th. For 6-12 grade students, grades earned during the 2nd 9 weeks along with the 1st semester determine eligibility to participate in sports and extra curricular activities for the second semester. Below are the policies for eligibility:

Kansas State High School Activities Association (KSHSAA) requires:

- Students must have passed at least five (5) new subjects the previous semester and shall be enrolled in and attending a minimum of five new subjects (those not previously passed), during the present semester. (If a student does not meet this requirement, they will be ineligible for KSHSAA activities for the entire following semester.)

Oxford Jr/Sr High School eligibility requires:

- On a nine weeks basis, a student in grades 6-12 may not have more than one failing grade the preceding nine weeks in order to be eligible in any KSHSAA or USD 358 sanctioned activity during the current nine-week school period.
- On a weekly basis, eligibility checks will be conducted during each season. Students who have earned a zero on an assignment and/or are failing any courses at the time of an eligibility check will be deemed ineligible for the next week.

Elementary Recess Reminders

During the winter season, elementary students will go outside for recess unless the wind chill and/or temperatures make it unsafe. Make sure your child has a coat, hat, and gloves to stay warm. The school does have coats for those who need assistance. Contact the elementary office or nurse Shera Neises for more information.
