Oxford High School Students Earn Recognitions

Daniel Williams, a senior at Oxford High School, has been named one of 51 finalist for the RUDD Foundation Scholarship. The next step of the competition requires each of the finalist to participate in an interview over the next several weeks. After the interviews are completed, the Foundation will evaluate the applicants and narrow the pool to 25. In late March, the organization will award 25 full ride scholarships for students to use to attend Emporia State, Wichita State, or Fort Hays State.
