Birth To 5 and Pre-School Screenings Sign-up Now!

On Friday, March 3rd, 2023 from 8:00 a.m - 3:00 p.m., Sumner County Educational Services will offer a free developmental screening to children, ages birth through 5. If you are interested in how your child is growing and developing, please call Oxford Oxford Elementary at 620-455-2410 to schedule an appointment.

Parents of birth to 2.5 years old, will meet one on one with a provider, and will be asked about how your child is developing. Parents of children 2.6 years old and up, will rotate through 4 stations, so please plan to spend about an hour at the screening. Screenings will be held at Oxford Elementary. The screening results are also used to determine eligibility for 3 and 4 year old priority enrollment in Oxford's Pre-School program. If your child is currently enrolled in Oxford's preschool, or is already receiving special education services through 619, it is not necessary to have him/her screened. If you have any questions or concerns, please talk with your child's teacher. This is a cooperative effort among Sumner County Educational Services Interlocal District #619 and USD #358
