•**Returning Students**- For those families who have a PowerSchool Parent Account log in to your account. Next navigate to the left side of the screen to find a link labeled "FORMS." In the main section of the page, there will be a list of forms to edit, complete, and submit. Once all forms are shown as completed, you've successfully finished this step. If you have more than one child, click on the tab in the top of the screen with the next child's name, and repeat the process.

•**If you do not have a PowerSchool Parent Account- you will need to create one.** Packets with your student codes are being mailed Thursday, July 13th.

•**New Students**-If you haven't already, go to www.usd358.com and navigate to the ENROLL page and click on the Pre-Enrollment Link to complete the first step. Once your pre-enrollment is approved, you will get an email outlining the steps to create your PowerSchool Parent account.

•**Out of District**- All returning and new students who live out of the school district must complete the out of district approval form found on the Enroll page at www.usd358.com

•**Returning Virtual School Students**- Complete the virtual school pre-approval form on the Enroll page prior to completing the PowerSchool enrollment process. The page can be found at www.usd358.com

•**Free and Reduced Lunch Applications**- It is important that applications to receive free or reduced meal prices be completed as soon as possible so that approval is in place for your child by the 1st day of school. Online Enrollment-

Kansas Star Reward Card pick-up @ OHS - Parents are eligible for one, \$100 gift card per K-12 student enrolled in the Oxford School District. **Steps:** **1.** Finalize enrollment and go to the payment station, Kansas All Star Gift Cards will be distributed. **2.** Show a valid form of identification. Only parents or legal guardians may pick up cards. **3.** Sign next to the student's name, agreeing the cards will be used for school related purchases

only/school fees. **4.** Return all purchase receipts to the school by September 15th. ***New students to the district must be in attendance for two weeks in order to receive a Kansas All Star Gift card.***

Everyone is invited to stop by your classrooms, meet your teachers, get a hot dog dinner at the high school, then enjoy a FREE family swim night at the Oxford swimming pool. Orientation Day: **August 22nd** is an orientation day for grades 7th, 9th new students in grades 8, 10, 11, and 12. (This will be a full day of school). Pre-school, Kindergarten and new students in grades 1-6 will be by appointment (Teachers will be in contact to set those times.)

First Day of School: The first day of school will be August 23rd for ALL STUDENTS. School supply list can be found on the district webpage and is included in mailed enrollment packets.

Sports Physicals- Tuesday, August 8th COST \$15 Cash or Check Only- Students in grades 6-12 planning to participate in any Oxford athletics for the 23-24 school year are REQUIRED to have a NEW KSHSAA completed physical signed (by student, parent, and medical professional) and Concussion & Head Injury Information Release Form.
