# Dean Dalinghaus

State Assessments – Grades 3-8 and 10 in Math and Reading and 5, 8, 11 in Science. Juniors will be taking ACT or the Work Keys on February 25 & 26. CPR certification training for grades 9 and 11 was completed January 30. The Centrali 5<sup>th</sup> grade came to Frankfort on February 7 for an Engineers Expo. FHS scholars bowl place 2<sup>nd</sup> at TVL meet and both boys and girls basketball place 3<sup>rd</sup> at TVL tournament.

#### Larry Glatczak

Parent teacher conferences went well, doing it again this Wednesday. Both junior high basketball teams placed 3<sup>rd</sup> at OTL basketball tourney. The student leadership group is going to Nemaha Centralia February 12 for training. State Assessments – Grade 3-8 and 10 in Math and English/Language Areas and Grade 5, 8, 11 in Science. The ACT test will be given February 26 for juniors. CHS girls' basketball team place 2<sup>nd</sup> at TVL tourney. Regional basketball will be at Valley Falls February 24-29 with Sub State to be the following week at Marysville or Riley County. Centralia school geography champion was Lawson Osterhaus and the Spelling Bee champion was Jacie Koch.

# B) Curriculum Director Report

Data from the staff perception pertaining to the Discussions with the Board in December was provided for the members. A proposed option for the 2020-21 school calendar was shared with the members and is currently out for parent and teacher feedback, which will be provided at the March meeting with any suggested changes. The teachers discussed the Dyslexia Recommendations from KSDE and visited with a Wonders (ELA) resource representative at the January Professional Development day. Teachers are currently providing feedback and voting on the materials for the future adoption. AIMSweb grade-level testing data was also presented to the members to review the progress from fall to winter benchmarks in both reading and math.

# D) Superintendent Report

Administrators have met with secretaries regarding online enrollment. The Frankfort staff will be going to Centralia to observe Wonders being used in the classrooms. Small, Rural Schools grant money was used to purchase 70 iPads for Centralia and Frankfort elementary. Midwest Coating is replacing Frankfort roof. That project should be completed very soon.
