JOB DESCRIPTION HEARD COUNTY SCHOOLS: School Psychologist FLSA: Exempt

The school psychologist assists in the intervention and evaluation process for students experiencing academic and/or behavioral problems. The School Psychologist should have completed a Master's degree or higher program in a Georgia Professional Standards Commission approved program and possess a Georgia certificate as required by the Georgia Department of Education for specified position.

REPORTS TO: Special Education Director JOB OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Responds appropriately to referrals for psychological assessment in a timely manner.
- 2. Conducts individual comprehensive psychological assessment.
- 3. Uses professionally accepted practices and standardized procedures as set forth in the instruments' manuals in test administration and scoring.
- 4. Provides differential diagnosis in areas of intellectual disabilities, learning disabilities and emotional/behavioral disorders.
- 5. Provides appropriate recommendations and intervention for at-risk students.
- 6. Prepares written reports that follow state guidelines in a timely manner.
- 7. Analyzes and integrates collected data.
- 8. Writes reports that are organized and easily understood by other professionals in the schools.
- 9. Verbally communicates assessment results with parents, teachers, and other pertinent members of an RTI or IEP team.
- 10. Participates in eligibility and program decisions for children with disabilities.
- 11. Participates in professional learning opportunities provided by the GA Department of Education and other related professional organizations.
- 12. Performs other duties as assigned by the Special Education Director.
- 13. Practices in accordance to Federal, State, and Local regulations and professional ethics.
- 14. Comply with the Georgia Code of Ethics for Educators.
