#### **ABSENCES**

If your child is absent, please call the office before 9am to let us know he/she is out & why. If we don't hear from you by 9, we are required by law to call you. If there is no contact made, that absence is considered unexcused!

If you take your child out on vacation, that requires approval from the principal – all work must be turned in the day your child returns to school.

Each student can miss 2 days per quarter without a doctor's note and still qualify for our Quadruple A Club, which is a quarterly reward. Any days after those 2, would require a doctor's note or funeral card to be considered excused for the purposes of Quad A.

All absences will still be part of the permanent record for each student, whether excused or unexcused & will show up on their report card.

Truancy is when a student has 5% or more unexcused absences.

#### **PANTHER-WEAR:**

Every Friday is spirit day & we encourage students & staff to wear their Panther gear. Order forms came home at Back to School Night. All orders & money are DUE by September 1<sup>st</sup>. Checks should be made payable to Grantfork Elementary!



#### **TUMBLERS**

#### QUADRUPLE A CLUB

At Grantfork, we have an incentive program called Quadruple A Club. Students have the opportunity to earn the privilege to be part of the Quad A Club. Student eligibility will be determined based on four criteria:

Accountability (students can forget 2 times/quarter)

- Overdue library books
- Not returning permission slips, notes, report cards, midterms, etc by the due date

#### Achievement

All "C's" and above on their report card

#### Attendance

- Missing two days or less during each quarter
- Absences due to quarantine or with a doctor/dentist note or funeral card do not count against AAAA.

#### Attitude

Receiving "no outs" for the entire quarter

We have a "3 strikes = you're out" per week policy.

3 strikes = "out note".

1 strike = warning,

2 strikes = warning,

3 strikes = "out note" sent home for parent signature

Please remember this program is not used as a punishment, but as an incentive & reward.





### SCHOOL STORE/REWARD-CESS:

On Monday afternoons, from 2:15 – 2:30, students have the opportunity to have an extra recess. During that time, we sell snacks at the "school store" out the Art room window. This is not linked in any way to your child's lunch account. They must have cash in hand – everything is \$50 cents or \$1.00. Below is a list of items & their prices:

Students may purchase 2 items – but not 2 of the same items. Students must have exact amount – we cannot make change!!
